American Folk Art A FAUX SCRIMSHAW PROJECT



During off-duty hours, many sailors on whaling ships expressed their artistry by decorating whale ivory, bone and baleen with intricate carved designs. These artists were called scrimshanders.


Students today can get a feel for the process by carving designs into wax candles to create a "faux scrimshaw" work of art.


MATERIALS NEEDED

- Votive candle (white or ivory colored) 2" tall by 1 1/2" diameter
- Pointed carving tool (a mechanical pencil works well)
- Brown shoe polish (cake style in a can)
- 2 soft cloths one for applying polish and a clean one for buffing the surface
- Masking tape
- Paper
- Pencil

DIRECTIONS

- Sketch a nautical design onto a 2" tall by 5" wide area on a piece of paper or tracing paper. (See sample designs on this page)
- On the reverse of your sketch, color the whole design area with a thick layer of pencil. This will act as carbon paper to transfer the design to wax.
- Tape your design to the candle.
- Transfer your design to the wax candle by tracing over your lines with a pencil.
- Remove the paper. A light imprint of your design should be visible
- Using the carving tool, trace over your design. As you trace, you should dig in a bit to create a recessed line. Brush away excess wax as you go.
- With a cloth, rub shoe polish over your design. Be sure to get enough polish to fill the cracks of your design.
- With a soft polishing cloth, rub off excess polish. The only polish remaining should be in the lines of your design.
- You're done! It's fun to see your design appear, isn't it!
- Optional: If you are a confident carver, you may want to carve directly on the candle without using the sketch transfer process.
